I often feel that I am in a front row seat watching our mighty Father do so many amazing things at Faith Christian Academy. Along with this rapid growth, we are experiencing growing pains. Our current Jr/Sr High enrollment is 42 (an FCA record) for this year...but we already have 45 enrolled for next year. We are planning where we will most comfortably fit each class- and each student's belongings, as well as how to best utilize each teacher and staff person. You can see why our Building Committee has a very important job!
