

INTERNET POLICY

Purpose

The goals of this policy are to outline appropriate and inappropriate use of Internet resources, including the use of browsers, electronic mail and instant messaging, file uploads and download, and voice communications. Use of these services is subject to the following conditions.

Appropriate Use

1. Homework
2. Approved Educational Sights
3. Research

Inappropriate Use

1. The Internet may not be used for illegal or unlawful purposes, including, but not limited to, copyright infringement, obscenity, libel, slander, fraud, defamation, plagiarism, harassment, intimidation, forgery, impersonation, illegal gambling, soliciting for illegal pyramid schemes, and computer tampering (e.g. spreading computer viruses).
2. The Internet may not be used in any way that violates policies, rules, or administrative orders. Use of the Internet in a manner that is not consistent with, misrepresents or violates any policy is prohibited.

Security

For security purposes, users may not share account or password information with another person. Internet accounts are to be used only by the assigned user of the account for authorized purposes. Attempting to obtain another user's account password is strictly prohibited. You may not download any programs, which may introduce a Trojan or a virus, into the system.

Failure to Comply

Violations of this policy will be treated as disobedience. A student who cannot comply with the internet policy will be given a detention. Repeated offenses may result in a suspension. If the student has not repented after suspension, they will be brought before the board for further action.
